North East: Potential Growth Area

According to the National Skill Plan, the North East is one of the potential growth corridors for the future. Skills development for domestic workers however is not well developed and poorly coordinated among the stakeholders in India. Very few programmes or support services are available on a national and regional basis and what is available is typically unstructured, fragmented with quality gaps. Furthermore, training given at such an individual institutional level is most not recognized by employers or those bodies with regulatory roles in the education and training system.



Aim

The aim is to facilitate linkages among various stakeholders in the sector for improved service delivery for the clients and improved reward package for the workers. The quintessence is achieving last mile connectivity and ensuring positive outcomes for the entire industry.
